This position is part of UCF's key teaching team. The successful candidate is responsible for the administration and further development of the LAS Core Program and will contribute to curricular development and integration with other parts of the LAS program. He/she is furthermore responsible for recruiting and coordinating Teaching Fellows from the University of Freiburg and beyond for Core courses in Responsibility and Leadership. The position has a teaching load of 2-3 LAS courses per year.

We expect candidates to have

- an interdisciplinary academic background
- a recent Ph.D.
- teaching experience and experience in coordinating teaching
- native or near-native English and very good German
- networking skills
- excellent interpersonal skills and the willingness to engage with innovative teaching methods

- participate in an initiative that is breaking new ground for the University of Freiburg and has been receiving attention far beyond
