

  - Application period: June 1 July 15
  - Interviews: July 31 August 4 (for EU Applicants only)
  - Welcome Week starts October 9, teaching starts October 16

- 2. Application documents by surface mail
  - Application form
  - Higher education qualification ("Abitur" or equivalent)
  - Language proficiency English at min. B2 level
  - Letter of motivation (max 1,000 words)
  - Study orientation test (required for matriculation) → e.g. the LAS Online Study-Choice Assistant (OSA)



- 3. 1<sup>st</sup> Ranking based on higher education qualification
- 4. Interviews (July 31 August 4)
  - Invitations about 1 week after the application deadline
  - Interviews at UCF with letter of motivation as starting point
- 5. 2<sup>nd</sup> Ranking based on your "Selection Score" (higher education qualification and interview score)
- 6. Letter of Acceptance mid-August

- 3. Ranking based on higher education qualification
- 4. No Interviews!
- 5. Letter of Acceptance mid-August

#### Tuition Fees as of Winter Semester 2017/18

- €1,500 per semester non-EU/EEA students; exemptions e.g. for exchange students, German Abitur, or residential status in Germany
- €650 per semester for students seeking a **Second Degree**
