The What – Primary Education Project



- Problem: Children in small villages in remote areas in the North have little access to primary education
- Development Goal: To foster the development of the remote areas by reducing the number of children that cannot go to school and increasing the overall quality of education.
- Outcome: Build two strongly constructed classrooms and a playground for children 6-11 years old from La Hu ethnic minority

The What – Eco Hub Project

Problem:

- Vietnam's agricultural sector has utilized practices which have caused a serious environmental crisis in Vietnam. (esp. Pesticides)
- Environmental education among youth is lacking
- The gap between rural and urban communities is widening
- Development Goal

The ECO Hub project aims to promote youth involvement in environmental protection and safe food production, and enhance education for sustainable development among youth.

Outcomes:

- Organic demonstration farm in Hoa Binh (rural area; ECO Hub) as live-learning facility
- Environmental Education Program for youth in Hanoi and Hoa Binh
- Community Learning Center in Hoa Binh



So What?

Practical experience in project planning

Reflection:

Several problems that hinder local NGOs in the Global South from being fully accountable to their community and the society

- As their financial means are limited, they need to be flexible for funding opportunities by international donor agencies.
- In order to do so, they use vague community specific language in developing their goals e.g. "sustainable development"
- This leads to lack of common direction and expertise

Future studies:

Local focus: My semesterlong stay in Singapore will give me the chance to study issues that come with the rapid development of SEA.
