Primary responsibilities will include

- correcting exercise sheets.
- assisting during the examination process and for correction of exams (week of July 22-26).

Candidates must

- have a B.A./B.Sc. degree (recognized in Germany) or being shortly before completing it
- be familiar with the theoretical background and application of basic descriptive and inference statistics (e.g. data illustration, correlation, regression, parametric and nonparametric test statistics).
- be able to teach basic procedures in the statistics package R to beginners.
- have excellent English skills (the language of teaching is English).
- be a reliable colleague.
