

University College Freiburg invites applications for a Lecturer in Environmental and Sustainability Sciences (50% E13)

The **University of Freiburg**, founded in 1457 and situated in the heart of Europe, has 24,000 students, an academic staff of 4,500, and 11 faculties ranging from the Humanities and Medicine to the Social, Natural and Technical Sciences.

University College Freiburg (UCF) is a central university facility for international, interdisciplinary teaching activities and new approaches to instructional design. As a cross-faculty platform, it houses several high-profile projects, amongst them the English- taught B.A./B.Sc. program in **Liberal Arts and Sciences** (LAS). UCF is currently looking for a

Lecturer “Environmental and Sustainability Sciences” (50% E13) as a temporary replacement during parental leave and for the project VirtualLAS II.

This teaching position is part of the core team of the LAS program. The lecturer will be responsible for teaching in the LAS Major “[Environmental and Sustainability Sciences](#)” that focuses on the interactions and interdependencies between human activities and the environment. The Major has a strong focus on sustainability, understood as a question of **balancing environmental, social, and economic objectives**. The teaching load is approximately 10 SWS (including supervision of projects and theses). Please note that the position is not research-oriented.

We expect candidates to have

- at minimum an M.Sc. (or equivalent), preferably a Ph.D. in Environmental Sciences or in an area relevant to the Major (e.g. Ecology, Biology, or other natural sciences with relevant focus)
- experience in teaching and in the supervision of student projects
- very good English and proficiency in German as well as strong intercultural communication competencies
- organizational skills, creativity, and flexibility in international and interdisciplinary contexts

Candidates with interdisciplinary academic experience and a proven interest in innovative approaches to higher education will be given precedence.

At UCF, we offer you the opportunity to

- develop your academic career by acquiring a broad range of excellent teaching skills and instructional design competencies
- participate actively in an innovative educational initiative
- work in close co-operation with an interdisciplinary, highly motivated and supportive team

The successful candidate is expected to start on February 1, 2022. The position re-numerated on the TVL E13 scale, will run at least until August 31, 2022, and is intended as a temporary replacement during parental leave. The current jobholder, [Dr. Sabine Sané](#), will continue to work part-time.
