

University College Freiburg invites applications for a Lecturer in Political Sciences

University College Freiburg (UCF) is a central university facility for international, interdisciplinary teaching activities and new approaches to instructional design. As a cross-faculty platform, it houses the English-taught B.A./B.Sc. program in Liberal Arts and Sciences (LAS).

UCF is currently looking for a Lecturer in Political Sciences (50% E13) as a temporary replacement during parental leave (September 2024 – March 2026).

The lecturer will be responsible for teaching in the [LAS Major "Governance"](#).

Namely, during the winter semester 24/25, the lecturer will need to offer a course on political theory (8 ECTS) and another social science course (6 ECTS), preferably on social science methods. During summer semester 2025, the lecturer will offer a course on comparative politics or policy analysis and another, senior, political or social sciences course.

Additionally, the lecturer would be involved in Bachelor thesis supervision, curriculum development, support of students and the strategic planning of the social sciences Major.

This position is not research-oriented.

We expect candidates to have

- preferably a doctorate in political or social sciences, but at minimum a Master's degree
- interest and experience in teaching
- excellent knowledge of English
- self-reliance, teamwork skills, flexibility in international and interdisciplinary contexts

You will be part of a team, which will provide you space and support for

- acquiring and honing teaching skills and instructional design competencies
- contributing to an innovative educational initiative
- developing interdisciplinary competences and communication
