UCF is seeking to hire a Teaching Assistant ("geprüfte wissenschaftliche Hilfskraft") for the Major area of Culture and History within LAS. The successful candidate will assist the Coordinator for Culture and History in the teaching and administration of the curriculum.

Primary responsibilities will include:

- teaching in the "Introduction to Culture and History" (e.g., introducing basic humanities methods, leading discussions, responding to student assignments, etc.).
- assisting teaching staff in the preparation, administration, and examination of courses offered in Culture and History (e.g., preparation of course materials, maintenance of the online learning platform ILIAS, support in grading papers and exams, etc.).

Candidates should:

- at minimum have a BA degree in a field of the humanities or related social sciences (History, Art History, Philosophy, Language and Literature, Anthropology, Cultural Studies, Gender Studies, Science and Technology Studies, or similar).
- be currently enrolled in an MA program in the humanities or related social sciences.
- be enthusiastic to teach well beyond their fields of specialty.
- have excellent English skills (the language of teaching is English).
- be flexible and reliable colleagues.
