The Liberal Arts and Sciences (LAS) Bachelor program, under the supervision of an interfaculty Board of Studies, is the UCF flagship project. This four-year interdisciplinary course is the first program of its kind at a large German research university. It is fully taught in English.

Teaching Fellows **should hold a PhD or Master's Degree** in Statistics, Economics, the Social Sciences or a related field, have experience using quantitative research methods and be enthusiastic about teaching. We provide the opportunity to further develop your teaching skills with a highly motivated interdisciplinary group of students, in a flexible and supportive environment.

This particular Teaching Fellowship will cover 60 hours of teaching in the semester long course on "Dealing with Numerical Information" at the University College Freiburg. Typically, a **Teaching Fellowship comes with an award of 2000-3000 €**, depending on the Fellow's seniority. The summer semester 2020 lasts from April 20 to July 25, 2020 (with no teaching during the university Pentecost holidays June 1–6).
