Teaching Fellows commit to teaching a course in the LAS program and receive financial compensation through a lectureship ("Lehrauftrag") or third-party funding ("Drittmittel"). We are especially looking for someone to teach an introductory undergraduate course on

and are also very interested in teaching fellows from the areas of

## Neuroscience, Immunology, and Biomedical Engineering

for both, introductory and advanced level undergraduate courses.

University College Freiburg (UCF) is the University of Freiburg's central facility for promoting and administering international, interdisciplinary teaching activities. The Liberal Arts and Sciences (LAS) Bachelor program, under the supervision of an interfaculty Board of Studies, is the UCF flagship project. This four-year interdisciplinary course is the first program of its kind at a large German research university. **It is fully taught in English.** 

Teaching Fellows **should hold a PhD** in their field and be enthusiastic about teaching. We provide the opportunity to further develop your teaching skills with a highly motivated interdisciplinary group of students, in a flexible and supportive environment. A Teaching Fellowship typically covers a 6 credits course with 40 hours of teaching. These can be taught in different formats ranging from semester long courses through seven-week block courses to two-week intensives. Co-teaching and the supervision of student projects or bachelor theses may also be possible. Typically, a **Teaching Fellowship comes with an award of 2000-3000 €**, depending on the teaching project and the Fellow's seniority. UCF accepts applications continuously. Winter semester 2019/20 is from October 21, 2019 – February 14, 2020 .The dates for the blocks are October 21 – December 13, 2019 (Block I) or December 16, 2019 – February 21, 2020 (no teaching during the university Christmas break) (Block II).
