





Application and Admissions

- EU → UCF: application@ucf.uni-freiburg.de
- Non-EU → IAS: <u>international@service.uni-freiburg.de</u>
 - Recognition of non-German high school diplomas
 - DAAD: <u>Admission Requirements</u>



- Key dates
 - Application period: June 1 July 15, 2016
 - Interviews: August 1-5, 2016 (EU Applicants!)
 - LAS Welcome Week starts October 10, 2016
 - LAS Teaching starts October 17, 2016





Application Process

- Online registration via the SCS Student Portal: http://www.studium.uni-freiburg.de/ studieninteressierte-en/studienfaecher-en
- 2. Application documents by surface mail
 - Application form
 - Higher education qualification ("Abitur" or equivalent)
 - Language proficiency English at B2 level
 - Motivational letter (max. 2 pages)
 - Study orientation Test (required for matriculation)





EU (incl. German) Citizens

- 3. 1st Ranking based on higher education qualification
- 4. Interviews
 - UCF sends out invitations for interviews by email and mail (starting one week after the application deadline)
 - Interviews at UCF using your motivational letter as starting point (August 1-5, 2016)
 - 2nd Ranking based on your "Selection Score" (higher education qualification + interview score)
- 5. Letter of Acceptance mid August





Non-EU Citizens

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- 3. Ranking based on higher education qualification
- 4. No Interviews!
- 5. Letter of Acceptance mid August
