- International LAS teaching staff at UCF












After LAS

4 Basic Steps

1. Application

You register, upload, and submit your application online.

2. Recognition

We check if they are complete and valid.

3. Selection

Based on grades, essay, letter of motivation

4. Admissions

Letter of acceptance or rejection
