

Who are we?

ImMUNity is UCF's own MUN committee. We're a **group of students** who are passionate about **politics**, **philosophy**, **ethical dilemmas**, and all sorts of different topics that you can **debate** and negotiate about.

The committee was founded about one and a half years ago by three LAS students who, by now, have graduated. Kora (she/her mostly), Jakob (he/him), Lottie (she/her), Lilli (she/her), Sarah (she/her) and Joyce (she/her) have taken over the organisational part and have since been working hard to organise all sorts of events for every interested LAS student.

What do we do?

MUN stands short for **Model United Nations**, which is a debate format meant to provide participants an insight into (among others) diplomacy, international relations, legislature, and human rights. ImMUNity is a committee that **organises events centred around debating, the United Nations or other skills and topics related to MUNs themselves**. Before the pandemic, our main focus was the preparation of delegations to MUN **conferences** such as the Geneva International Model United Nations – however, as large in-person events are currently not the most prudent of choices, we are currently focused on smaller, internal events. For that, we are having **weekly committee meetings** on Zoom where we discuss, plan, and prepare our **current projects**.

At the moment, we're planning to have an **Avatar: The Last Airbender Negotiation Simulation** in either November or December of 2020. This will be a small, fun event in which you can test your debating skills and dive into ATLA lore. Furthermore, we want to prepare a **Game Night** centred around strategy and hidden role games such as Coup or One Night Werewolf.

And lastly, an event we have been planning for months already: **FreiMUN** – an **MUN conference here in Freiburg**, to take place in September 2021. We're hoping that by that point, COVID will no longer be a problem and we can safely organise an in-person conference for everyone to have fun.
